

SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT OF DIVERSION AND USE FOR 2017

To Whom It May Concern:

Receipt of this letter constitutes legal service to SANDRA JEAN VAROZZA of the enclosed Administrative Civil Liability Complaint and provides notice of the intent of the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division) to assess a monetary penalty for violating State Water Board regulations.

YOU HAVE 20 DAYS TO ACT OR YOU MAY FACE ADDITIONAL FINES AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS. THIS MATTER REQUIRES YOUR IMMEDIATE ATTENTION.

VIOLATION DESCRIPTION:

SANDRA JEAN VAROZZA is required to file an Supplemental Statement of Diversion and Use (Supplemental Statement) by July 1 of each year, and has failed to do so. State Water Board regulations require Supplemental Statements to be filed by July 1 of the succeeding year for every water right claim. (See Title 23, Chapter 2.7, Article 2, Section 920 of the California Code of Regulations)

MAXIMUM AND PROPOSED PENALTY FOR VIOLATION:

The maximum penalty allowed by law for this type of violation is \$500 per day for every day after the deadline where the Supplemental Statement has not been submitted. The State Water Board can impose a fine for failing to submit the Supplemental Statement by the deadline (110 days at \$500/day) of up to \$55,000.

The State Water Board is required to consider all relevant circumstance prior to issuing a monetary penalty. The Division has reviewed the relevant circumstances of the case, and has determined that the appropriate proposed liability for failure to file the 2017 Supplemental Statement by July 1, 2018, is **\$1,500**.
