On September 9, 2020, Amador Water Agency (AWA) submitted an objection to the Department of Water Resources' (DWR) proposed testimony and exhibits and a motion to cancel DWR's protest. In addition, El Dorado Irrigation District (EID) submitted an objection to DWR's proposed testimony and exhibits and a statement in support of AWA's motion.

Hearing Officer Maguire's August 20, 2020 procedural ruling following the Pre-Hearing Conference states that parties will be permitted to respond orally to any written objections during the hearing. However, given the nature and extent of the objections and motion, Hearing Officer Maguire now directs DWR to submit a <u>written</u> response to AWA's objection and motion and EID's objection to <u>wr hearing.unit@waterboards.ca.gov</u> and serve it on the other parties on the current Service List **no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 17, 2020.** Written replies to DWR's response will not be accepted.

Hearing Officer Maguire intends to issue a ruling on these matters prior to the hearing, which is scheduled to commence on September 29, 2020, to allow parties to better prepare for their participation.
