



State Waters Resources Control Board

The Delta forms the West Coast's largest estuary, providing habitat for more than 500 species of wildlife. It serves as a major stopover for the Pacific Flyway and as a migration path for salmon traveling to and from their home streams to the Pacific Ocean. For decades the Delta has faced serious decline. Up to 6.8 million acre-feet (2.2 trillion gallons) of water per year are pumped from the southern Delta south for agriculture and urban uses.

Additional Delta water diversion must be stopped now! The Delta must be protected and improved now!

The Central Valley big Ag and southern California water demands can not continue to be a priority for the Board.

Please do not support or pass any action that will divert any additional water from the Delta south, it is not an open endless faucet!
