As we have discussed the Joint Water Districts Board and Western Canal Water District are subject to the SWRCB's February 4, 2015 Informational Order (Order). Based on the terms of their Settlement Agreements with the Department of Water Resources (Department) both Districts assumed they would have full water supplies under those Agreements in 2015 when they submitted information regarding their projected 2015 diversions as required under the Order. On April 8, 2015 the Districts were officially informed that, based on the forecasts contained in the Department's April 1, 2015 Bulletin 120, they would receive only 50% supplies under the Settlement Agreements. This email is being sent on behalf of the Joint Water Districts Board and Western Canal Water District to provide revised Projected 2015 diversions for the remainder of the year.
