## Water Rates and Meter Charges

Water rates, or commodity charges, are billed according to the amount of water used by each type of customer, and (1 HCF = 7.48 Cubic Feet, 1 HCF = 748 gallons). Fixed meter charges are based on the size of a customer's meter.

Urban Conservation (less than or equal to 4 HCF)	\$4.12
Urban	\$4.30
Recreation Irrigation	\$3.11
Reclaimed	\$2.49

Urban Agricultural	\$1.16
West Conduit System Agricultural	\$1.06

5/8" & 3/4" Meters (Based on average 12 month water use)	
Ultra-low Flow (4 or less HCF)	\$10.68
Low Flow (5 to 8 HCF)	\$21.37
All other 5/8" & 3/4" Meters	\$32.05
1 - inch	\$53.43
1 1/2 - inch	\$106.84
2 - inch	\$170.96
3 - inch	\$320.54
4 - inch	\$534.24
6 - inch	\$1,068.46
8 - inch	\$1,709.56
10 - inch	\$4,060.84
