The purpose of this hearing is for the State Water Board to receive evidence relevant to determining whether Permits 19164 and 19165 (Applications 26306 and 26307) should be revoked, because the Permittee has failed to commence, prosecute with due diligence, and complete the work necessary to appropriate water under the permits, and because the Permittee has not made beneficial use of the water in accordance with the permits, the Water Code, and the State Water Board's regulations.
