Attached are Imperial County's notice of intent of 25 February 02, and proof of service of today of that notice.

To clarify points addressed by IID correspondence of 1 March, while the County may be securing up to two additional witnesses who will address impacts in Imperial County, those witnesses' time would fall within the one hour estimated originally for planning director Heuberger. We hope to be able to identify those witnesses next week. As for participation, we anticipate that any county witnesses would testify in phase II, though as a protestant Imperial County may also participate in phase I depending on the testimony there. We note that IID itself has reserved the right to name or call additional witnesses, a prerogative that Imperial County recognizes must be sparingly used and with appropriate justification.
