Complete Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, Notification No. 1600-2017-0135-R1, Marble Mountain Ranch Diversion, Stanshaw Creek.

On March 15, 2017 the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) received your Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration (Notification). On April 14, 2017, your Notification was deemed complete.

CDFW is required to submit a draft Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement (Agreement) to you within 60 calendar days from the date the Notification is complete, if CDFW determines that an Agreement is required for the project. An Agreement will be required if CDFW determines that your project could substantially adversely affect an existing fish or wildlife resource. Therefore, CDFW has until June 13, 2017 to issue you a draft Agreement or inform you that an Agreement is not required.

Please be advised that you may not proceed with any work until CDFW executes an Agreement, informs you that an Agreement is not needed, or does not provide you with a draft Agreement within 60 days of the date your notification was deemed complete.
