Request for Declaration of Status of Public Water System, Marble Mountain Ranch,

Public water System #4700812, Somes Bar, Siskiyou County

This office received the "Declaration," dated December 21, 2005, in which you document that your noncommunity water system did not meet the definition of a public water system. You declared that your facility has no more than 14 service connections and does not serve 25 or more people daily for at least 60 days out of the year.

At that time, we agreed that your facility did not meet the definition of a public noncommunity water system. Accordingly, we placed this system on our list of inactivated facilities.

Recently, we have received information suggesting that the Marble Mountain Ranch may be serving water to at least 25 people daily at least 60 days out of the year. Therefore, we are requesting that you apply for a permit to operate a public water system or, if your system still does not meet the definition of a public water system, sign and return the attached "Declaration".

Operation of a Public Water System without a valid permit is a violation of the California Health and Safety Code, Section 116500.
