Is hereby given, that I have taken up and hold for mining and irrigating purposes, six hundred inches of the water running in Stanshaw creek, so called, the water so taken, being caused first by ditch and flume, to and past my dwelling house; second by ditch and flume running up the Klamath River to my upper fields, Genet creek being in Dillon Township, State of California, County of Klamath

Notice: Is hereby given to all to whom it may concern that I have taken up and hold for mining purposes one hundred inches of the water running in the Creek, that empties in to the Klamath River on the west side, and directly opposite the head of "Tay Ben", and known as the "Frenchman's" Creek said creek being in Dillon Township, State of California, County of Klamath
