## NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF PUBLIC HEARING

### SUBJECT OF THE CANCELED HEARING

On October 24, 2008, the Assistant Deputy Director for Water Rights issued an Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Complaint and a draft Cease and Desist Order (CDO) against North Gualala Water Company (NGWC). By letters received November 10 and 12, 2008, NGWC requested a hearing on the Complaint and draft CDO.

By Notice of Postponement of Public Hearing, dated May 15, 2009, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) postponed the May 27, 2009 hearing upon receipt of requests for postponement by the NGWC and Prosecution Team. On June 9, 2009, the State Water Board's Executive Director approved a Settlement Agreement between the Prosecution Team and the NGWC ([ORDER 2009-0036-EXEC](#)). Accordingly, no hearing is required to be held on this matter, and the previously postponed hearing is cancelled.
