Reminder of Submittal Copies (unless Amended by the Hearing Officer)

You must submit to the State Water Board <u>3 paper copies</u> and <u>1 electronic copy</u> of each of your exhibits. For hand delivery, courtiers must first check in with lobby security, then deliver the submittals to the Water Rights' Records Room to be date and time stamped.

Reminder of Time Limits (unless Amended by the Hearing Officer)

- > Opening Statements: 5 minutes per party.
- Direct Oral Testimony: 10 minutes total per party to summarize or emphasize all of its written testimony. As parties must submit all direct evidence in writing prior to the hearing, oral testimony serves to highlight or explain the key points in the evidence already submitted.¹
- > <u>Cross-Examination</u>: Initial limit of 15 minutes per witness or witness panel per party.

Requests for Additional Time

The hearing officer may, for good cause, approve a party's request for additional time to present direct testimony during the party's case-in-chief. The hearing officers also have discretion to allow additional time for cross-examination if there is good cause demonstrated in an offer of proof.

These limits remain in force and effect.

Ex Parte Communications

Ex parte communications with State Water Board members or members of the Hearing Team are prohibited. Therefore, any communication concerning substantive or controversial procedural issues relevant to this hearing must be copied to all parties on the enclosed service list.
