PURPOSE OF WORKSHOP

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will hold a public workshop to receive progress reports from the Monterey County Water Resources Agency (MCWRA) and the Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency (PVWMA) regarding their efforts to control seawater intrusion into the groundwater aquifers in the Salinas Valley and the Pajaro Valley. The State Water Board will also receive information from the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD) regarding water supply and water quality issues affecting the Carmel River. The California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) will give a progress report on its compliance with State Water Board Order 95-10¹.

PROCEDURAL MATTERS

This is an informal workshop. The State Water Board will not take formal action at the workshop. In addition, there will be no sworn testimony or cross-examination of participants. The State Water Board and its staff may, however, ask clarifying questions.

¹ In Order 95-10, the State Water Board directed Cal-Am to obtain water rights and develop a project to cover its illegal diversion and use of water and to implement measures to minimize harm to public trust resources of the Carmel River.


