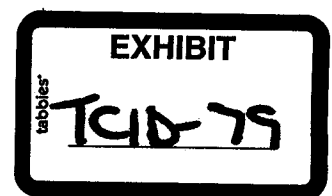

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

Water to be appropriated from Little Truckee River tributary to Truckee River.

In the County of Sierra.

Amounts applied for: 350 cubic feet per second by direct diversion and
126,000 acre-feet per annum by storage.

Diversion season named: Direct diversion from April 1 to November 1 and
storage from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

Water to be used for irrigation, flood control and recreational purposes.

Point of diversion: Stampede Dam within NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T 19 N,
R 17 E, MDB&M.

Place of use described: Irrigation of 26,800 acres in Truckee Meadows (gross
area, 36,340 acres) in T 18, 19 and 20 N, R 18, 19, 20 and 21 E, MDB&M;
irrigation of 70,000 acres in Newlands Project (gross area, 107,140 acres)
in T 17, 18 and 20 N, R 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31 E, MDB&M.

GENERAL PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT

Water diverted at Stampede Dam in Section 28, T 19 N, R 17 E, will be released to Truckee River below the Calvada Power Plant in Section 30, T 19 N, R 18 E, and a small part will be rediverted at numerous points on the Truckee River in T 19 N, R 18, 19 and 20 E, MDB&M to Truckee Meadows Lands.

At Derby Dam in Section 19, T 20 N, R 23 E, the remainder will be rediverted through Truckee Canal to Lahontan Reservoir on Carson River and rediverted at Lahontan Dam in Section 33, T 19 N, R 26 E. Final rediversion will be made at numerous points on the Carson River in T 19 N, R 27, 28 and 29 E, MDB&M to Newlands Project lands. The project is shown on U. S. Bureau of Reclamation Map No. 320-419-156 filed with State Engineer.

RELATIVE TO PROTESTS

Blanks upon which to submit protests will be supplied free upon request.

Any person desiring to protest against the granting of such permits shall within 60 days from date hereof file with the Department of Public Works, State Engineer, Sacramento, California, a written protest. Such protest shall clearly set forth the protestant's objections to the approval of the application and shall contain the following information:

- (1) Statement of the injury which would result to protestant from such appropriation and use.
- (2) The basis of protestant's water right.
- (3) Protestant's past and present use of water both as to amount used and land irrigated, or use made of water if other than irrigation.
- (4) The approximate location of protestant's land or place of use and point of diversion of the water.

A copy of the protest should be sent to the applicant and this office notified that the same has been done.
