Representatives from a broad spectrum of interests in Sonoma County coalesced two years ago to create a sustainable watershed partnership: the Salmonid Coalition (Coalition). The goal of the Coalition, which includes participants from private stakeholders, public agencies and conservation groups, is to create programs that will contribute to the recovery of protected salmonids in Alexander, Dry Creek and Knights Valleys of Sonoma County while balancing the need to provide for regional economic viability and regulatory certainty.

A number of participants in this Coalition have developed a Watershed Approach Work Plan (Attachment A) to restore ecological flows for salmonids and provide increased water security for rural agriculture. This Watershed Approach promotes collaboration and provides the framework for water users to effectively manage the water resources of a watershed by maximizing the beneficial uses of water while protecting the environment and public trust resources.

The purpose of the Coalition's Watershed Approach Work Plan is to establish water management solutions, to improve water supply reliability, and maintain instream flows for fish.
