NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: That I have this day taken up and appropriated two hundred inches of water of Butte Creek in said County and State, measured under a four inch pressure. Said water taken from said creek at the point where this notice is posted and conveyed from thence by means of ditch to be constructed for conveying the same. Said ditch to be built 4 feet wide on top, 18 inches deep and 18 inches wide on the bottom, grade not less than 1/8 inch to the rod. Said ditch to be about 4 miles in length and conduct said waters to the premises of the undersigned, and then to be used for irrigating purposes.
