#### NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0109

COUNTY: Modoc STREAM SYSTEM: Pit River

The City of Alturas (Petitioner) has filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division) pursuant to Water Code section 1211. The Petitioner requests authorization to reduce the discharge of treated wastewater down to zero cubic feet per second (cfs) from the City of Alturas Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) to the Pit River during all months of the year. The reduction in discharge is due to decommissioning of the existing WWTF and construction of a new WWTF in a new location and change in discharge location from the Pit River to land discharge in nearby percolation/evaporation ponds.
