### NOTICE OF PETITIONS FOR EXTENSION OF TIME, FOR WATER RIGHT PERMITS 15016, 15019, 15020, 15021, and 15023 (APPLICATIONS 12911, 13092, 13093, 18727, AND 19148) OF CALAVERAS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

COUNTIES: Calaveras, Tuolumne, and Alpine STREAM SYSTEMS: Highland Creek, Beaver Creek, and North Fork Stanislaus River

On January 9, 2025, Calaveras County Water District filed petitions for water right Permits 15016, 15019, 15020, 15021, and 15023 (Applications 12911, 13092, 13093, 18727, and 19148), with a request for time extensions on the remaining portions of the permits to December 31, 2032, with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division).

Permits 15016, 15019, 15020, 15021, and 15023 allowed developments until December 31, 1992, to complete application of the water for non-consumptive power generation.
