Notice of Minor Change to Water Right Application A030800

Klein Foods, Inc. has filed a request for a minor change under Water Code section 1700.4, seeking to make changes to pending water right application A030800. The project associated with the application and minor change is in Sonoma County and would divert water from the Mark West Creek stream system.

Summary of Water Right Application A030800

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on October 15, 1998.

Sources of Water: The sources of water are: (1) an Unnamed Stream tributary to Windsor Creek thence Mark West Creek thence the Russian River; and (2) Windsor Creek tributary to Mark West Creek thence the Russian River.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is from December 15 of each year through March 31 of the succeeding year.

Diversion Methods and Amount: Water will be diverted via onstream dam and diversion to offstream storage. The rate of diversion to offstream storage will not exceed 2 cubic feet per second. The total amount of water diverted will be limited to 35 acrefeet per year. The total quantity of water diverted under any right issued pursuant to Application A030800 and the applicant's existing rights pursuant to licenses 5335 and 5797 shall not exceed 35 acre-feet per year.

Points of Diversion: Water will be diverted at points 1 and 2 and stored and rediverted at Point 1 (Reservoir 1):

- Point 1 (Reservoir 1) is a point of diversion, point of rediversion, and place of storage located within the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- Point 2 (Offset Well) is a point of diversion located within the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purposes of Use: The purposes of use for water are irrigation, frost protection, heat control, and incidental recreation.

Places of Use: The place of use for incidental recreation is at Reservoir 1. The place of use for irrigation, frost protection, and heat control is 45 acres of vineyard as follows:

- 7 acres within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 1;
- 8 acres within the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 1;
- 20 acres within the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 1;
- 10 acres within the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 1;
- All within Township 8 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Summary of Minor Change

Sources of Water: The sources of water have not changed.

Seasons of Diversion: The season for diversion of water has not changed.

Diversion Methods and Amount: The diversion methods, rate of diversion to offstream storage, and maximum amount of water requested for diversion have not changed.

Points of Diversion: Point 1 has not changed. Point 2 has been changed as follows:

 Point 2 (Portable Electric Pump) is is a point of diversion located at North 1,968,113 feet and East 6,331,247 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purposes of Use: The purposes of use for water have not changed.

Places of Use: The place of use for incidental recreation at Reservoir 1 has not changed. The place of use for irrigation, frost protection, and heat control has been updated for mapping accuracy to 48.08 acres of vineyard as follows:

- 5.3 acres within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 1;
- 11.5 acres within the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 1;
- 19.23 acres within the Northwest guarter of the Southeast guarter of Section 1;
- 12.05 acres within the Southwest guarter of the Southeast guarter of Section 1;
- All within Township 8 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Application and Minor Change Documents
