## State Water Resources Control Board

### Notice of Minor Change to Water Right Application A023393

A minor change has been initiated under Water Code section 1700.4 to make minor changes to water right application A023393 of the South Tahoe Public Utility District. The project associated with the application and minor change is in El Dorado County and would divert water from the Lake Tahoe stream system.

#### Summary of Water Right Application A023393

**Date of Filing:** The application was filed with the State Water Board on November 7, 1969.

**Sources of Water:** The source of water is Lake Tahoe, which is tributary to the Truckee River.

**Season of Diversion:** The season for diversion of water is January 1 to December 31 of each year.

**Diversion Method and Amount:** Water will be diverted by direct diversion, and will be limited to 19,000 acre-feet per year at a rate not to exceed 52.5 cubic feet per second.

**Points of Diversion:** Water will be diverted from three points:

- The first point is located at North 2,119,546 feet and East 7,144,579 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 27, Township 13 North, Range 18 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The second point is located at North 2,112,338 feet and East 7,135,995 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 32, Township 13 North, Range 18 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The third point is located at North 2,109,236 feet and East 7,125,814 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within Lot 3 of Section 5, Township 12 North, Range 18 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

**Purpose of Use:** The purpose of use for water is municipal.

**Place of Use:** The place of use for water is the service area of the City of South Lake Tahoe, being within Townships 11, 12, and 13 North, Range 18 East, and Townships 12 and 13 North, Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

## Summary of Minor Change

**Source of Water:** The source of water will not change.

**Season of Diversion:** The season for diversion of water will not change.

**Diversion Method and Amount:** The maximum amount of water requested for diversion will change to 6,390 acre-feet per year. The method of diversion and rate of diversion will not change.

**Points of Diversion:** The points where water will be diverted will not change.

**Purpose of Use:** The purpose of use for water will not change.

**Place of Use:** The place of use will not change.
