Notice of Minor Change to Water Right Application A031635

Hestan Vineyards has initiated a minor change under Water Code section 1700.4, seeking to make changes to pending water right application A031635. The project associated with the application and minor change is in Napa County and would divert water from the Ledgewood Creek stream system.

Summary of Water Right Application A031635

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on August 30, 2006.

Source of Water: The source of water is an Unnamed Stream tributary to Gordon Valley Creek thence Ledgewood Creek thence Peytonia Slough thence Suisun Slough thence Suisun Bay.

Amount: The maximum amount of water requested for diversion is 160 acre-feet per year.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is from November 1 of each year through June 1 of the succeeding year.

Point of Diversion: Water will be diverted from three points:

- The first point is located at North 1,878,890 feet and East 6,530,307 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The second point is located at North 1,877,040 feet and East 6,527,657 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 31, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The third point is located at North 1,879,040 feet and East 6,530,407 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purpose of Use: The purposes of use for water are irrigation, frost protection, heat control, incidental recreational, and incidental fire protection.

Place of Use: The place of use for incidental recreational and incidental fire protection is at the reservoirs. The place of use for irrigation, frost protection, and heat control is 87 acres as follows:

- 3 acres within the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 31;
- 7 acres within the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 31;
- 15 acres within the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 32;
- 4 acres within the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 32;
- 30 acres within the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32;
- 21 acres within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32;
- 2 acres within the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 32;
- 5 acres within the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32;
- All within Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Summary of Minor Change

Amount: The maximum amount of water requested for diversion has been changed to 146 acre-feet per year.

Points of Diversion: The points where water will be diverted has been changed by removing the second Point of Diversion.

Place of Use: The place of use for irrigation, frost protection, and heat control has been changed to 59.9 acres as follows:

- 0.8 acre within the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 31;
- 0.1 acre within the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 31;
- 7.3 acres within the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 32;
- 4.2 acres within the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 32;
- 19.8 acres within the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32;
- 18.1 acres within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32;
- 4.9 acres within the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 32;
- 4.2 acres within the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32;
- 0.5 acre within the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32;
- All within Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
