ORDER WRO 2002-0013, AN ORDER APPROVING THE LONG-TERM TRANSFER
OF WATER FROM THE IMPERIAL IRRIGATION DISTRICT TO SAN DIEGO COUNTY
WATER AUTHORITY, THE COACHELLA VALLEY WATER DISTRICT, AND THE
METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will consider the adoption of a proposed order revising State Water Board Order WRO 2002-0013, an order approving the long term transfer of water from the Imperial Irrigation District to the San Diego County Water Authority, the Coachella Valley Water District and the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California.

BACKGROUND

On October 28, 2002, the State Water Board issued Order WRO 2002-0013¹ that approved the long-term transfer of water from the Imperial Irrigation District to the San Diego County Water Authority (SDCWA), the Coachella Valley Water District and the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California. On November 18, 2014, the Imperial Irrigation District (IID) filed a Petition for Change seeking modification of Revised Order WRO 2002-0013. In May 2015, Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr. established the Salton Sea Task Force to identify realistic short and medium term goals to respond to potential air quality and ecological impacts resulting from scheduled reduced flows of fresh water to the Salton Sea. The State Water Board regularly monitors and assesses progress on the implementation of the Salton Sea Task Force's Salton Sea Management Program (SSMP), and has held six public workshops as part of this function. California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA) has prepared Phase 1 of the SSMP in furtherance of its Salton Sea Restoration objectives and is committed to constructing and maintaining habitat and dust-suppression projects that address public health and environmental concerns. The SSMP contemplates future phases, and a long-range plan.

On March 15, 2017, IID filed a motion with the State Water Board seeking to have an evidentiary hearing to address its November 18, 2014 petition regarding Salton Sea Restoration. As a result of the motion, a draft stipulated order was developed for consideration by the State Water Board during a public workshop held on September 7, 2017. The draft stipulated order was revised following comments at the workshop and subsequent negotiations, resulting in a final draft stipulated order being shared with the State Water Board on October 20, 2017. CNRA, IID, SDCWA, Imperial County, Audubon California, Defenders of Wildlife California, Sierra Club California, and the Pacific Institute (collectively Supporting Parties) have attested to their support for the final draft stipulated order.

The final draft stipulated order acknowledges agreements and commitments reached among the Supporting Parties related to the SSMP, accepts the schedule of activities and milestones for SSMP Phase 1, and sets a schedule for information collection and future workshops before the State Water Board. The final draft stipulated order recognizes the restoration activities that are underway or planned and requires reporting on those activities.

The State Water Board has prepared a proposed order based on the final draft stipulated order, which will be considered for adoption during the November 7-8 Board meeting.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

For purposes of CEQA, CNRA is the lead agency for restoration actions described in the SSMP and referred to in the proposed order. The proposed order itself is not a project subject to CEQA. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15061, subd. (b)(3).) To the extent that the proposed order is subject to CEQA, the proposed order is categorically exempt from CEQA under the Class 4 categorical exemption for minor alterations to land, the Class 6 categorical exemption for information collection, the Class 7 categorical exemption for actions by regulatory agencies for protection of natural resources, and the Class 8 categorical exemption for actions by regulatory agencies for protection of the environment. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, §§ 15304, 15306, 15307, 15308.) If the State Water Board adopts the proposed order, it will issue a Notice of Exemption.
