An application for a water quality certification (certification) under section 401 of the Clean Water Act for the following project was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board). The notice period may be shortened in an emergency.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** On March 8, 2023, Pacific Gas and Electric Company submitted a water quality certification application for the Battle Creek Hydroelectric Project – License Amendment for Removal of Inskip Diversion Dam (Project). The Project involves a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) license amendment to the Battle Creek Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 1121) to remove Inskip Diversion Dam which is located on South Fork Battle Creek in Tehama County. Following dam removal, the Project includes restoration of the dam area by creating a series of pools and riffle/steps/cascades.
