**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The City of Pasadena Water and Power Department has applied to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for a Conduit Exception, and to the State Water Board for water quality certification, for the Azusa Conduit Hydropower Project.

The Azusa Conduit Hydropower Project is located within the San Gabriel River Watershed and proposes to operate the existing Azusa Conduit and 3-megawatt Azusa Powerhouse for power generation.
