I have completed my review of the Draft EIR for the above referenced project. While most of the document is in compliance, there is a small error in the timeline for Most Likely Descendent (MLD) recommendations. The error is in section 4.8.2 (Regulatory Setting), subsection 4.8.2.2 (State), Discoveries of Human Remains which cites CEQA section 15064.5 (e) (2) (A) on page 4-193. Public Resources Code section 5097.98 (revised) states that the MLD has 48 hours after being allowed access to the site to make recommendations. We would appreciate it if you could make that change.
