It was very evident that the EIR report is obsolete and incomplete. We believe the entire report should be put aside and a new accurate report be done or forgo the entire process until it is much more clear as how the drought will affect the entire state of California. It appears to us at this time to be prudent in the handling of all water bodies no matter what the use is dedicated to.
