BEFORE THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD**

A request for water quality certification (certification) under section 401 of the Clean Water Act for the following project was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board). California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 3858, requires the Executive Director of the State Water Board to provide public notice of an application for certification at least twenty-one (21) days before taking certification action on the application. The typical notice period may be shortened in an emergency.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** On June 27, 2019, Pacific Gas and Electric Company filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for a new license for the Project. The Project consists of an approximately 10.9-mile-long transmission line and does not generate power. The Project transmits hydroelectric power from South Sutter Water District's Camp Far West Hydroelectric Project Powerhouse switchyard to a point of junction near the Beale Air Force Base metering station. The Project is located in Placer and Yuba counties and is approximately five miles northeast of Wheatland, California.
