**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Browns Valley Irrigation District (BVID) is proposing a tailwater recapture project (Project) that will relieve irrigation water supply constraints by pumping water from French Dry Creek. The Project includes a collection system within French Dry Creek and installation of approximately 11,000 linear feet of underground 24-inch pipeline ending at an existing irrigation canal known as the Pumpline Canal. The Project is located between State Highway 20 and the Yuba River in the Browns Valley area of Yuba County.
