- ① Requested Amount reflects the maximum quantity before any conveyance losses including Delta carriage water losses (which have preliminarily been estimated by DWR to range from 30% to 35%) and other conveyance losses.

- ③ If the comment deadline falls on a non-business day (Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday), the comment deadline will be extended to the next business day. If a holiday falls within the comment period, the comment period will be extended one business day.
- ④ All temporary transfers end immediately upon conveyance of the designated transfer quantity or one year from transfer approval, whichever occurs first.
