Thanks for your response to my telephone call today. Adrianna in the Office of Chief Counsel directed me to "Instructions" for filing petitions in the water quality section of the website, and she assured me that if all 9 elements referred to were received by the appropriate offices before legal deadlines, consideration would be given to the petition. Since I am requesting just one additional clarifying sentence in the 27 page order, I am hoping that I will not be in violation of some hyper-technical requirement that was not disclosed in the instructions.

The Water Quality Division seems to require mailing a copy of the Petition to the "Discharger." Does a similar requirement exist for the Division of Water Rights? I will be mailing a copy to people I know at Cal-Am Legal just in case.
