NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

PROPOSED ADOPTION OF THE STATE FISCAL YEAR (SFY) 2020-21 (FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 2020) INTENDED USE PLAN (IUP) FOR THE DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (DWSRF), INCLUDING A SUPPLEMENTAL IUP FOR THE ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR DISASTER RELIEF ACT OF 2019 (ASADRA), AND REVISED GUIDELINES FOR PROPOSITION 1 AND PROPOSITION 68 DRINKING WATER PROGRAMS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept public comment on the IUPs for the DWSRF program and revised guidelines for the implementation of Proposition 1 and Proposition 68 Drinking Water programs. The State Water Board will consider adopting the IUPs for the DWSRF program and revised guidelines for the implementation of Proposition 1 and Proposition 68 as early as the Tuesday, June 16, 2020 Board Meeting.

BACKGROUND

The DWSRF program provides low-cost financing to public water systems statewide to address drinking water quality and capacity issues. It also subsidizes a portion of California's public water system supervision program under the Division of Drinking Water.

The Proposition 1 and Proposition 68 Drinking Water programs provide funding for public water system infrastructure improvements and related actions to meet safe drinking water standards, to ensure affordable drinking water, or both. Proposition 1 and Proposition 68 Drinking Water funds will be administered consistent with the DWSRF IUPs and the DWSRF Policy to the extent allowed by federal regulations and state law.

The DWSRF IUPs outline the State Water Board's business plan for the DWSRF program as well as the Proposition 1 and Proposition 68 Drinking Water programs during SFY 2020-21. The IUPs identify the available funding, the projects the State Water Board anticipates financing, the associated financing terms, and the measures that will be used to track the DWSRF as well as the Proposition 1 and Proposition 68 Drinking Water programs' performance.

The DWSRF IUPs are required by federal statutes and regulations and will be included in the applications submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) for the FFY 2020 DWSRF Capitalization and ASADRA Grants. The DWSRF IUP also serves as guidelines for the implementation of the Proposition 1 and Proposition 68 Drinking Water funds in accordance with applicable State statutes.

The State Water Board will accept both written and oral comments on the proposed SFY 2020-21 (FFY 2020) DWSRF and ASADRA IUPs. If the Board adopts the SFY 2020-21 (FFY 2020) DWSRF and ASADRA IUPs, the adopted IUPs will be submitted to U.S. EPA as part of the State Water Board's applications for the FFY 2020 DWSRF Capitalization and ASADRA Grants.
